The showy new Aloe Rias displays a completely new colour combination, with its upright tubular two-tone flowers that are brick-red to orange, and tower over a rosette of foliage.

Rias will flower from a young age, but develops its maximum flowering potential after about four years, when it has grown a short trunk. Growing to 150cm tall and one metre wide, like most aloes the Rias is able to cope with the extremes of the Australian climate: excessive rain, drought, heat and cold.

In both garden and pot, aloes like good drainage in a full sun position, in all areas except the steamy tropics.
